<p>Psalms 109:4 - In return for my love they accuse me, but I give myself to prayer.</p>	<p>Prays for His enemies</p>	<p>Luke 23:34 - And Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do." And they cast lots to divide his garments.</p>
<p>Psalms 22:17, 18 - I can count all my bones-- they stare and gloat over me; they divide my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots.</p>	<p>Soldiers gambled for His clothing</p>	<p>Matthew 27:35, 36 - And when they had crucified him, they divided his garments among them by casting lots.
